Aquarium:	OPTIWHITENATURAL AQUARIO
Volume:	54 L
Light:	Custom made LED
Gravel:	Ebi Gold waterplant soil
Filter:	External JBL crystalprofi 900
CO2:	2 bubbles per second
Fertiliser (weekly):	Specialised Fertiliser 14 ml
Maintenance (hours per week):	<math>< \frac{1}{2}</math>

A)	Hemianthus callitrichoides 'Cuba'	(048B)	7 pcs.
B)	Eleocharis acicularis 'Mini'	(132B TC)	4 pcs.
C)	Riccia fluitans	(001 TC)	2 pcs.
