Close vegetation of *Myriophyllum Mattogrossense* and the high *Eleocharis* sp., make the background look elegant. Massive cliffs, surrounded by *Hottonia*, *Staurogyne* and *Microsorium*. A wide valley of *Cuba-Hemianthus*, mixed with *Echinodorus Tenellus* lead through smaller cliffs to the fine, light sandy shore. Please, go for a swim!

Aquarium:	JUWEL
Volume:	180 L
Light:	T5 Daylight 4 x 45W
Gravel:	Very light grey, grain size 0.8-1.2mm
Filter:	Internal filter
CO2:	25 mg/L
Fertiliser (weekly):	50 ml Premium Fertiliser + 50 ml Specialised
Maintenance (hours per week):	½-1
