This fountain of mangrove wood is the home of *Limnophila Sessiliflora*, *Rotala 'green'* and *Eleocharis* species.

All are plants, which enhance the effect, but require regular trimming. At the base, moss, *Anubias* and *Microsorium*, create a passage to the beautiful green plain along with *Marsilea Hirsuta* and *Glossostigma Elatinoides*, which *Eleocharis 'Mini'* has created in only few months. The landscape is comfortable calm and quite easy to maintain.
