A small and well-functioning aquarium!

This aquarium does not have an awful lot of light, but the quadratic layout ensures uniform light distribution.

A diagonal mangrove root creates coherence, depth and fine growing conditions for Anubias 'Petite'.

The fertile bottom layer of Lillaeopsis brasiliensis does not require much light and only limited care. The stem plants Hottonia and Rotala grow faster and require regular cutting.

Technique

Aquarium:	SUPERFISHWAVE 15
Volume:	15 L
Light:	LED 2100 lux
Gravel:	Flora Base black, small pellet
Filter:	Superfish Aquaflow 50
CO2:	Tropica System 60
Fertiliser (weekly):	Specialised Fertiliser 20 ml
Maintenance (hours per week):	$\frac{1}{2}$
