Aqua Decor products and a close wall of Spiky moss initially made this aquarium vigorous and easy to balance. Nymphoides and Pogostemon Erectus are the only fast-growing plants that require regular trimming. Lagenandra will over time get bigger leaves that may be too shadowy; they are easily removed. The moss wall is carefully lifted out and trimmed with scissors when required.

Fertiliser (weekly):	40 mL Premium + 80 mL Specialised
Maintenance (hours per week):	1-2
